

NOTICE OF PROPOSED BANK MERGER

Notice is hereby given that Rockland Trust Company, a Massachusetts bank with its main office located at 288 Union Street, Rockland, Massachusetts 02370 ("Rockland Trust"), filed an application on or about June 10, 2021, with the Boston Area Office of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (the "FDIC") to merge with East Boston Savings Bank, a Massachusetts bank with its main office located at 10 Meridian Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02128 ("EBSB").
