NARRATIVE

1. On Tuesday, March 31, 2009 at approximately 9:45 p.m., I, Officer Spera and Officer T.J. Leonard (C816), responded to Haymarket MBTA Station on the Orange Line southbound platform for a report of a person exposing himself. Upon arrival, the CSA [REDACTED] stated the reporting party was a female and the suspect was on the southbound platform.

2. We made our way to the southbound platform and conducted a canvas for a possible suspect. As we were on the platform a female, [REDACTED], on the Orange Line northbound platform, yelled across to me and stated, "Officer it's that guy in the brown jacket and baseball cap." I observed a white male, later identified as Richard Mullaney Jr, wearing a brown jacket, baseball cap, black jeans and black combat boots, carrying a backpack walking quickly away from me, southbound on the platform and attempt to hide behind a pole. I signaled to Officer Leonard and we stopped the suspect to conduct an FIO.

3. I went to the northbound platform and interviewed the victim, a person known to the Commonwealth. The victim was visibly alarmed and was uncomfortable explaining what she observed. She stated she was waiting on the platform and looked across the station to the southbound platform. She saw R. Mullaney Jr. facing a silver support column. The victim stated she could clearly see R. Mullaney's penis and genitals hanging outside his pants, his hands at his sides. R. Mullaney Jr. was looking at her as he was rocking back and forth, rubbing his penis and genitals against the support column. The victim was so "shocked and alarmed" by this behavior she immediately went to the lobby and requested CSA
